



General invitation and information for the 25m European Cup 2007 Center Fire Pistol and Standard Pistol

Dear shooting friends!

The European Shooting Confederation extends the number of competitions of the 25m European Cup to the benefit of the shooting sport in Europe. The 25m European Cup is a tournament in non-Olympic events. ESC also wants to offer for Center Fire and Standard Pistol shooters a possibility to participate at the major competitions like the ISSF World Cups in Olympic events. The 25m European Cup Regulations for this competition are enclosed. Five qualification competitions and the finals will be arranged as follows:

1. The first qualification round

will be organised by the Shooting Federation of Lower Saxony, in Hannover (GER) on 27-29. April 2007.

2. The second qualification round

will be organised by the Danish Shooting Union in Aarhus (DEN) on 11-13.5. 2007.

3. The third qualification round

will be organised by the Swiss Sport Shooting Federation in Riedbach (near Bern) (SUI) on 11-14.6. 2007.

4. The fourth qualification round

will be organised by the Zagreb Shooting Association in Zagreb (CRO) on 22-24.6. 2007. The competition will be supported by the Croatian Shooting Federation.

5. European Championships, Granada, 10-25.7.2007

According to the 25m European Cup rules, the results from the European and World Championships will be taken into consideration, in the year in which they are organised.

6. The Finals

will be organised in Zagreb (CRO) on 22-23.9.2007.

All organising federations above will send the detailed invitation for every part competition. After the part competitions and European Championships the qualified shooters will be invited to participate in the Final by the ESC Pistol Committee.

The updated ranking list will be published on the web site of ESC after every qualification round.
