



## **General invitation and information for the 25 m Walther European Cup 2011**

### **Center Fire Pistol and Standard Pistol**

The European Shooting Confederation extends the number of competitions of the 25 m European Cup to the benefit of the shooting sport in Europe. The Walther European Cup 25 m Pistol is a tournament in non Olympic events. ESC also wants to offer for Center Fire and Standard Pistol shooters a possibility to participate at the major competitions like the ISSF World Cups in Olympic events. The Walther European Cup 25 m Pistol Regulations for this competition are enclosed. Five qualification competitions and the finals will be arranged as follows:

**1. The first qualification round**

will be organised by the Deutscher Schützenbund e.V. in **Hannover (GER)**

**2. The second qualification round**

will be organised by the Dansk Skytte Union in **Aarhus (DEN)**

**3. The third qualification round**

will be organised by the Suomen Ampumaurheiluliitto in **Lahti/(FIN)**

**4. The fourth qualification round**

will be organised by the Swedish Sport Shooting Federation in **Öckerö/Gothenburg (SWE)** on 26.-28.08.2011. [www.skyttesport.se](http://www.skyttesport.se).

**5. European Championships,**

According to the 25 m European Cup rules, the results from the European and World Championships will be taken into consideration in the year in which they are organised.

**6. The Final**

will be organised by the Swiss Shooting Sport Federation in **Thun/(SUI)**

All organising federations above will send the detailed invitation for every part of the competition.

After the qualification round competitions, the qualified shooters will be invited to participate in the Final by the Pistol Discipline Group of the Technical Committee.

The update ranking list will be published on the web-site of ESC ([www.escsport.eu](http://www.escsport.eu)) after every qualification round, just as the Rules of Walther European Cup 25 m Pistol state.
