



## The general invitation and information for 25m Europa Cup 2006 Center Fire Pistol and Standard Pistol

Dear shooting friends !

The European Shooting Confederation extends the number of competitions of the 25m Europa Cup to the benefit of the shooting sport in Europe. The 25m Europa Cup is the tournament in non-olympic events. ESC want to offer also for Center Fire and Standard Pistol shooters a possibility to participate the major competitions like the ISSF World Cups in Olympic events. The 25m Europa Cup Regulations for this competition are enclosed. Four rounds and the finals will be arranged as follows:

**1. The first round** will be organised in the scope of Grand Prix of Liberation in Pilsen (CZE) on 3. - 7. 5. 2006. Czech Shooting Federation sent the Invitation to Grand Prix to all European federations, separate invitation to Europa Cup will not be sent. All federations participating on Grand Prix must only mark the shooters starting in the events concerned with the symbol GP or EC at the latest in the Final Entry Form for Grand Prix. The shooters will then pay the entry fee according to the competition concerned (GP or EC) and they will be classified in relevant result lists.

**2. The second round** will be organised by the Swiss Sport Shooting Federation in Bueren an der Aare (SUI) on 27. - 28. 5. 2006. The Invitation was already sent to all European federations.

**3. The third round** will be organised by the Danish Shooting Union in Aarhus (DEN) on 16. - 18. 6. 2006. The invitation is already prepared and will be sent without delay.

**4. The fourth round** will be included from the results of the World Championships in Zagreb (CRO) on 21. 7. - 1. 8. 2006. The results of all shooters participating in any of the previous rounds will be classified. The classification will be made by the ESC Pistol Committee.

**5. The Finals** will be organised in Lahti (FIN) on 1. - 3. 9. 2006. All necessary information will be sent later.

European Shooting Confederation cordially invites all European pistol shooters to attend the 25 m Europa Cup and wishes the best results to all of them.
