Lunch Lunch will be served at the shooting range. The lunch is 10 EURO per day and has to be ordered in the final registration (final entry form).

Barbeque evening

Saturday evening a barbeque will be arranged at Faxan Shootingcenter. Fee per person is 15 EURO. The barbeque has to be ordered in the final registration (final entry form).

Entry Fees Per shooter per event 75 EURO.

Custom clearance

Shooters from Denmark, Finland and Norway have to declare their weapons and ammunition to Swedish Customs before travelling to Sweden. This service can be found at Tullverkets homepage.

Shooters from other countries must have a special police permit to bring weapons and ammunition in and out of Sweden. The organizing committee will send you the needed form. One form for every group of shooters passing the border at the same time. There is a police service fee of 60 EURO for every permit. The organizing committee will request these permits and will advance the fees.

Notice! If you don't fill in firearms form and send to us and when you arrive to the Swedish custom make a group declaration, a fee of 60 EURO per weapon will be charged at the custom line.

Storage Storage of pistols and ammunition is arranged at the shooting range.
