The 10m Five shots Air Pistol is the ideal device to get started with dynamic pistol shooting. New members can be won for the shooting sport, which could be the future contributors for this interesting event.

It is easy for young persons and students to get to know the fast and exact shooting and to switch later to the 25m competitions. The technique for shooting at 25m can be learned and be trained effectively here.

Based on the easy scoring of the falling targets is this an ideal sport for beginners as well as other shooters, who just want to have fun.

All renowned manufacturers are offering five shot Air Pistols. The price is within the limits of the One-shot Air Pistols. Aside from these, there are also more budget-priced pistols, which might be less precise, but fully satisfying for the beginning.

Air pressure weapons can be purchased and transported without problems and are non-problematic at border crossings.

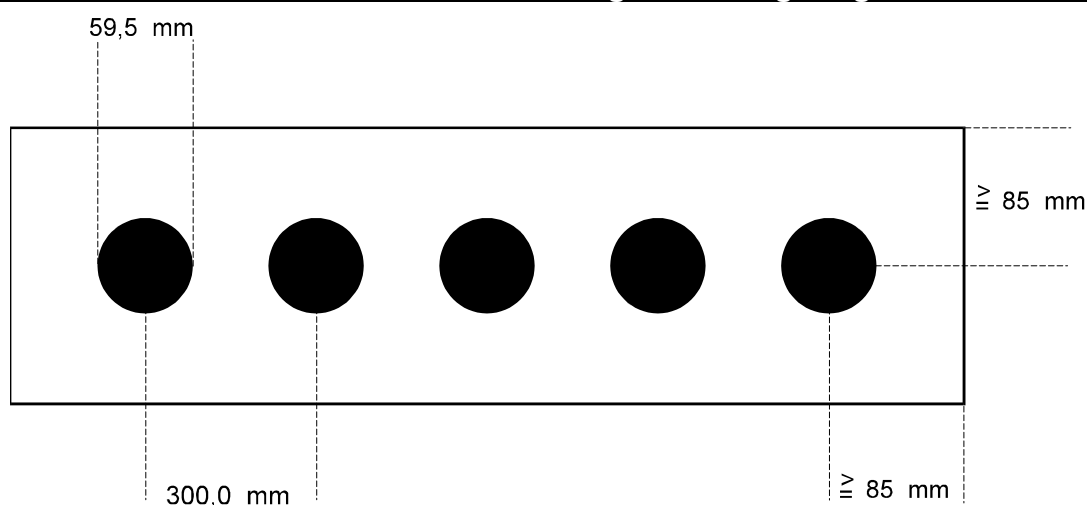
Falling Targets exist in different models and are available from several manufacturers.

The pricing of a simple version without electronics ranges from € 250.00 to € 300.00. For these targets no electricity is needed.

For electronically controlled targets the price ranges from approximately € 600.00 to € 1000.00. Here the covers are being blocked automatically after the shooting time is over.

Below you will find a suggestion how to organise a competition with a final. Just try it!

10 m Five Shot Air Pistol

1 Participants

- 1.1 All active shooters (Men, Women, Juniors Men/Women) at the _____(*1*) 10 m in _____(*2*) may participate in the 10 m Five Shots Air Pistol event. The best 8 participants from the Qualification round go forward to the Final Round. The Competition is a mixed competition (Men, Women, Juniors Men/Women in one class).
- 1.2 Visitors and Team Leaders may shoot for the EC – Pin in a extra Demonstration Round but cannot participate in the Final Round.

2 Event

- 2.1 The event is divided into a Qualification Round and a Final Round.
- 2.2 The Qualification Round will be carried out during the European Championships 10 m. The starting times are free and will be announced at the shooting range.
- 2.3 In the Qualification Round each shooter fires 8 series of 5 shots each in 10 seconds at each of the 5 Falling Targets (Ø of 30 mm). Before the beginning of the competition the shooter may fire 1 sighting series in 10 seconds.
- 2.4 The shooters will be ranked by the highest numbers of hits. The best 8 participants of the Qualification round may go forward to the Final Round. The ranking list of the Qualification Round defines the positions in the Final Round.
- 2.5 The Final Round will be conducted on 8 Falling Target groups in the Final hall in a KO-System (see the scheme).
- 2.6 Two shooters according to the starting plan fire in a group. Each shooter fires his series of 5 shots each in 10 seconds one (1) shot at each of the 5 Falling Targets (Ø of 30 mm) on a common command. The winner of the match goes into the next round.
- 2.7 Ties
- 2.7.1 Ties in the Qualification Round will be decided:
- The highest score of the last ten (2x5) shot series working backward by 10 shot series until the tie is broken.
 - If the results of all series are equal, ties must be decided by counting from the last shot of the last series backward until a miss is found. The shooter with the most hits in succession must be given the higher place.
 - If a further tie occurs the jury will decide by drawing lots.

4 Competition

4.1 Competition Rules

The ISSF Rules for the **10 m Five Shot Air Pistol** are valid if these are not modified in this event programme.

4.2 Protest

- 4.2.1 The Chief Range Officer decides in all cases of scoring, violations and questions about the rules.
- 4.2.2 In the event of a disagreement with the Chief Range Officers decision the Jury, appointed by the organisers, decides finally in all cases of protest.
- 4.2.3 The Protest fee is € 25,--. The fee for the matter in question will be retained by the Organising Committee if the protest is denied.

5 Organisers of the Competition

- 5.1 On behalf of the European Shooting Confederation (ESC) the _____(*6*) Federation is the Organiser of the Competition.

6 Pistols and ammunition

- 6.1 Pistols and ammunition will be not provided by the organisers. The shooter must use his own pistol.

7 Awards

- 7.1 Each participant on the Qualification Round will be awarded an EC – Pin.
- 7.2 All participants on the Final Round will be awarded with **a diploma and a prize**.

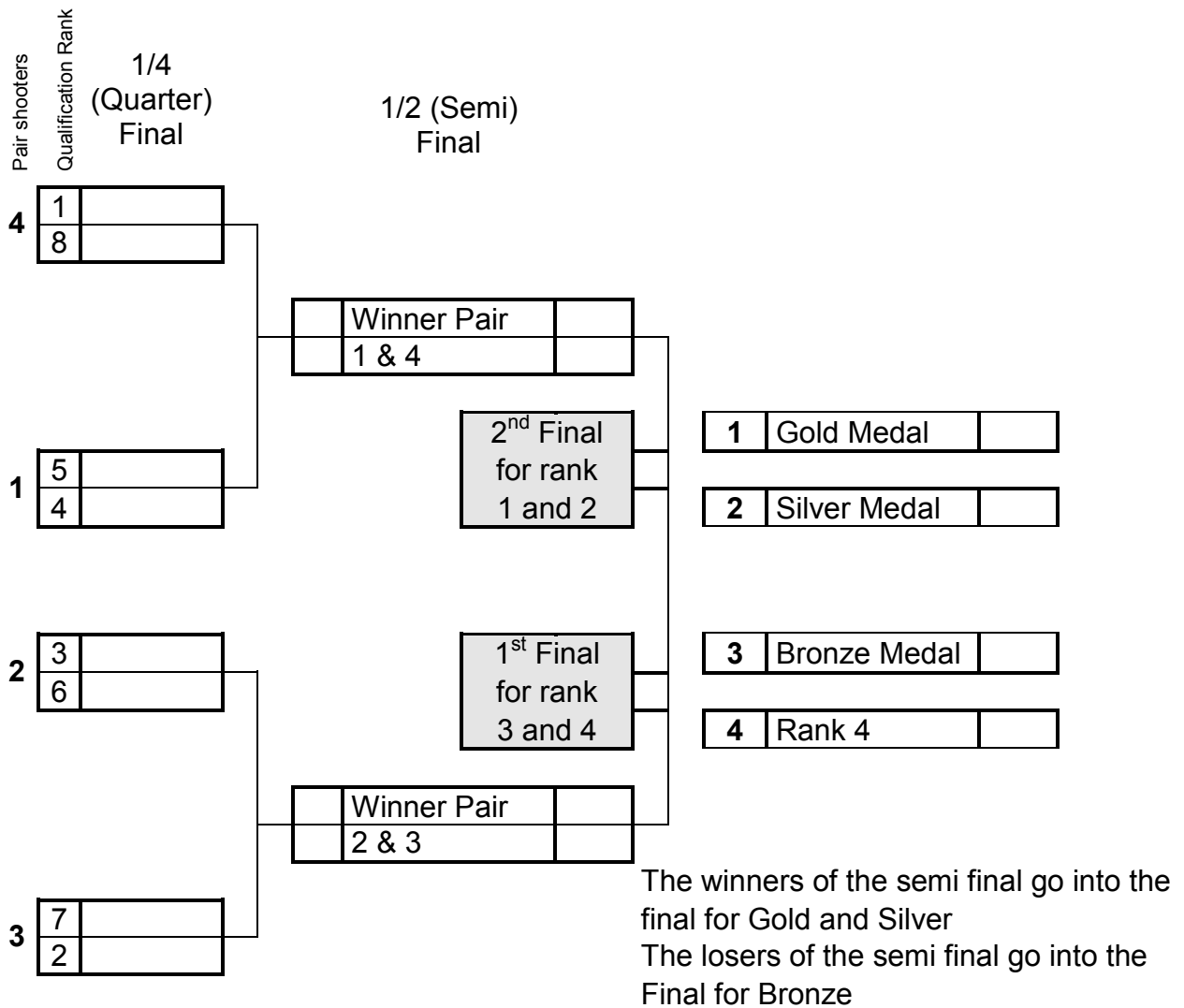

Final Round

- The shooters will be ranked by the highest numbers of hits. The best 8 participants of the Qualification round may go forward to the Final Round.

Starting positions in the Final Round:



5 Shot Air Pistol

The Final will be conducted on 8 firing points.
 The Semi Final will be conducted on 4 firing points.
 The Finals for place 1 to 4 will be conducted on 2 firing points.
 Two five (5) shot series ten (10) seconds
 1 minute Preparation time – 1 Sighting series
