## Inside ESC

### – ESC promotion videos now available online



The European Shooting Confederation started to promote a first series of two commercial videos about the Olympic shotgun shooting. ESC-President Vladimir Lisin and the Chairman of the Press and Promotion Committee, Andrey Sidorov, officially presented the videos during the European Shotgun Championship in Kazan.

The videos were produced by using special high speed cameras (2.000 frames per second). They show the dynamic of this discipline in a never seen way.

As special guest the members welcomed Mr Aleksey Kulakovsky, Secretary of the Presidential Council of the Development of physical culture and sports, Deputy Chief of the Department of the President of

Russia of maintenance of activity of the Russian Federation State Council and Head of the Presidium of "The Russian Olympians Foundation".

After visiting the new shooting range of Kazan, the Presidium Members unanimously agreed that the Organising Committee, the Russian Shooting Union as well as the representatives of Kazan and Tartastan did a perfect job to prepare such a professional Championship. They expressed their sincere thanks to all participants, athletes and persons in charge for their great engagement.



The next ESC Presidium Meeting will be organised in the forefront of the European Championship 10m in Brescia / Italy (March 1<sup>st</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> 2011).

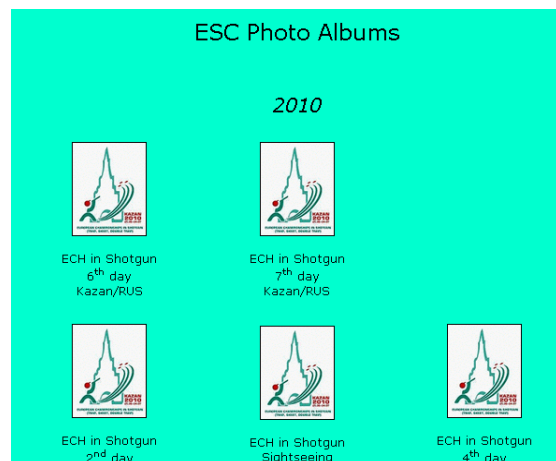
